Farmers for Soil Health Enrollment Information

The producer is responsible for all the items listed whether self-enrolling or guided by technical assistant*
Information will be directly input to the DTN Enrollment Platform.

** Conservation District Staff, Ks Soil Health Alliance and Heartland Soil Services staff are able to assist producers who do not have access to internet and or who need assistance with the online enrollment process.*

Create an Account:

- Name
- Valid email address

Enrollment:

- Mailing address (zip code)
- FSA Core Customer ID # (obtain from FSA)
- USDA farm, tract, or field numbers collected with Document Verification.
- EIN Number (Employer Identification Number) or SS Number (Social Security Number)

Field data:

- Field Name - A name recognized by the producer
- Acres - Acres to be cover cropped (the DTN platform estimated field acreage may differ from the actual planned acreage)
- Cover crop species
- Tillage information

Document Verification:

- **Field info**
 - FSA Farm, Tract, and Field numbers for each field
 - Cover crop species
 - Cover crop seeding rates
 - FSA Farm and Tract Maps (obtain from FSA, NRCS or Conservation District)
 - FSA Form 156EZ (obtain from FSA or NRCS)
 - Subsidiary Print for the year cost-share payment is issued (obtain from FSA)
 - W-9 form, used to verify Employer Identification Number or Social Security Number

 - AD 1026 - Highly Erodible Land and Wetland Certification Form
 - AD 2047 - Customer Data Worksheet
 - CCC 902 - Farm Operating Plan
