Conservation Symposium – Grand Eagle Ballroom Quality Water, Quality Life – Addressing Water Quantity and Quality Concerns in Kansas

Kansas is blessed with a rich agricultural heritage and vibrant economy deeply rooted in farming and industry. With a complex web of streams, surface water reservoirs, underground aquifers and a diverse climate, Kansas faces unique challenges in balancing the competing demands of agriculture, community development, industry and environmental conservation.
